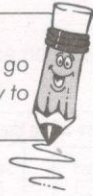


Hello friend!

REMEMBER

- Familiarize yourself with the answer sheet. Use this practice sheet given to you and fill all the details in the sheet.
- We have provided PAN numbers to students who have appeared in ASSET before. Please carry it along for marking the PAN Number on the Answer sheet in the designated area.
- For answer sheets, mark all the details using HB pencils only. Carry extra pencils during exam.
- Read the instructions & questions very carefully.
- Mark all your answers on the Answer sheet only. You may use the blank space given in the question booklet for rough work
- Each question has four options (A), (B), (C) & (D). Remember that you have to darken only one oval for each question. More than one darkened oval for a question will be treated as an incorrect or wrong answer. If you happen to erase any dark mark / shade on the answer sheet, erase it completely. The answer ovals should be shaded completely without leaving any space, as no marks will be given for wrong method of answering. The correct and wrong methods of shading are shown here:
- While filling in the answers during the test, keep checking that you are blackening the choice next to the correct question number
- Answer all questions. If you are not absolutely sure of the answer, take an intelligent guess
- Time yourself! After every 10-15 questions see how much time you have left, and whether you have to go faster.

Note for parents:
Make your child practice on the sheet to be familiar with the ASSET answer sheets.
