Work Education: In Vista, Work Education is viewed as purposive and meaningful manual work, organized as an integral part of the learning process besides the pleasure of self-fulfilment.

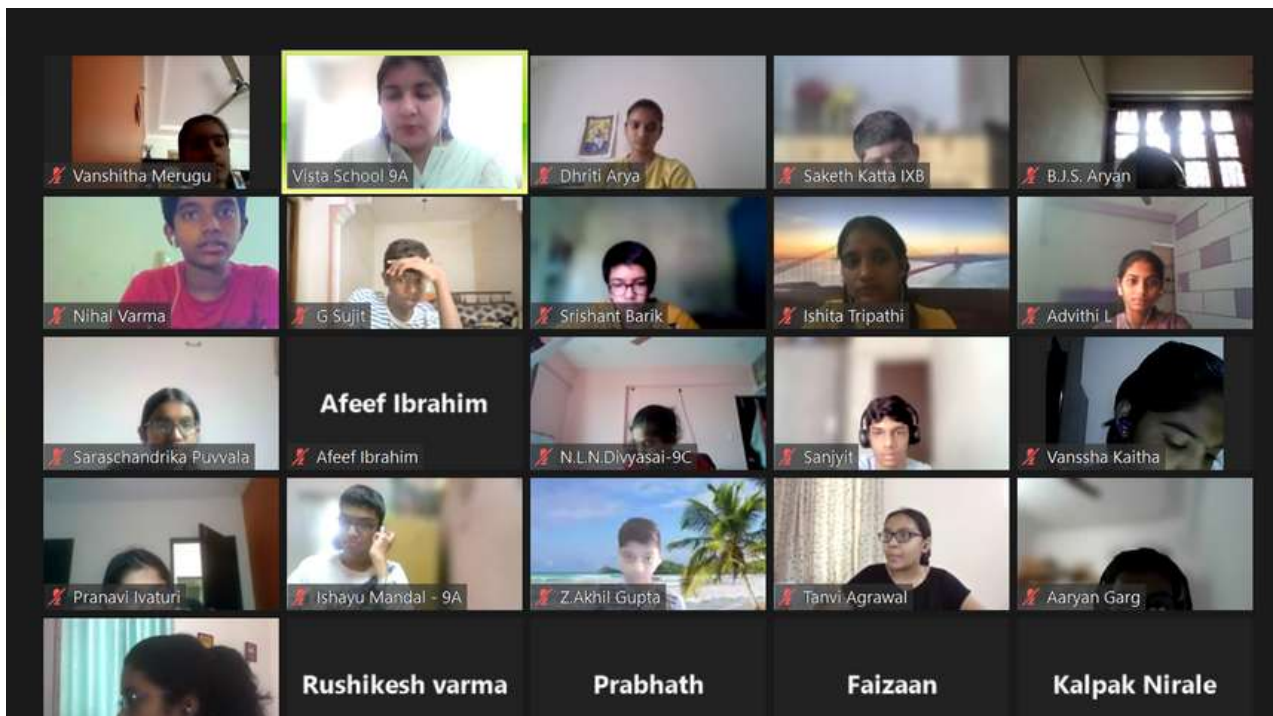
Art Education - From Canvas painting to canvas embroidery, from wall décor to decorative items, the Vistaians had fun learning new things.

Concentrated training is being provided by well experienced faculty to the interested students who have qualified for the required criteria. These classes are being taken online.



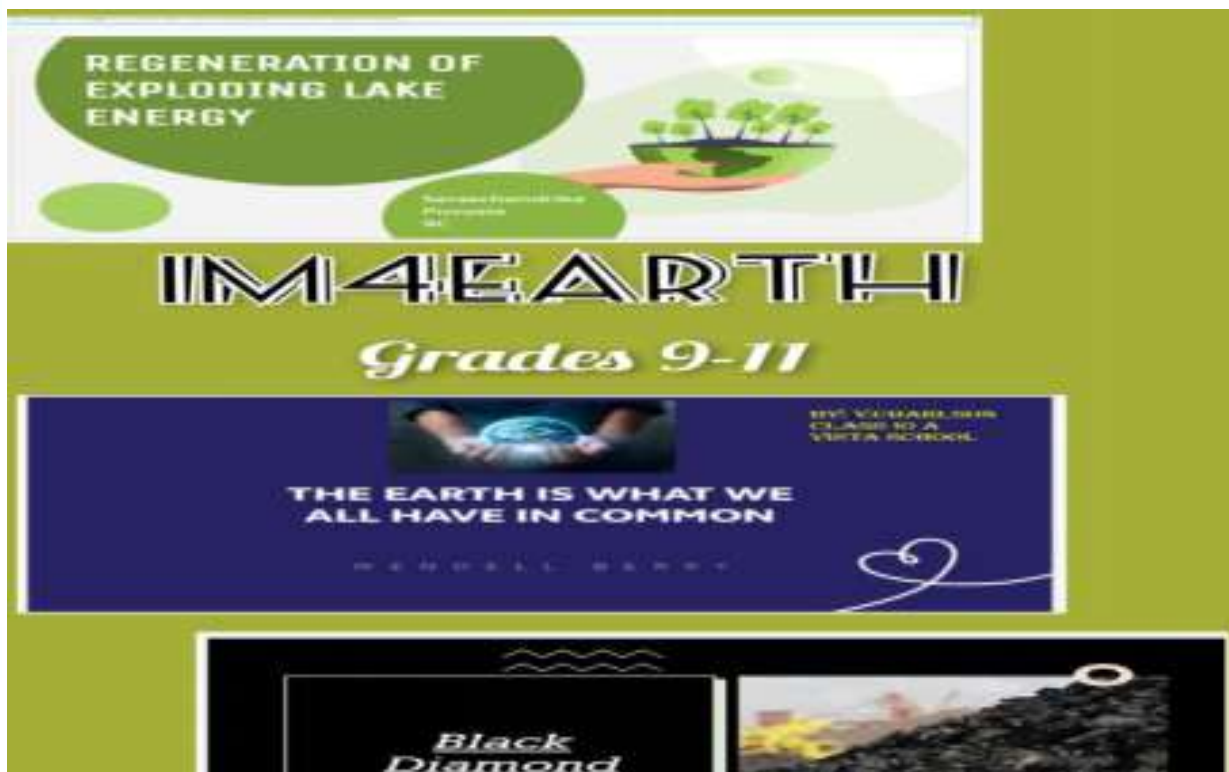
APP DEVELOPMENT- The students of Vista had great fun creating computer applications for use on devices.
