


Young Minds at Work

CCA: From literature to theatre, art or volunteer work, extracurricular activities at Vista help students pursue an interest or find a new one.


Weekly CCA clubs ensure a session full of fun and talent building, all rolled into 40 minutes of heartening effort from the students. Let us take a look at some of the activities....








THEATRE ARTS- Puppet Show


