Quote of the month: *“The only person you are destined to become is the person you decide to be.”- Ralph Waldo Emerson.*

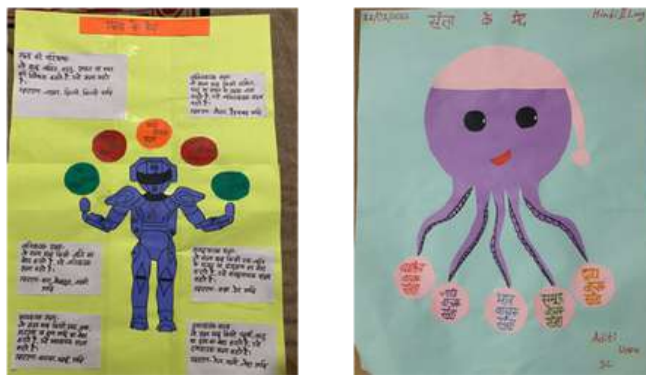
ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

Science: Students got hands-on experience of physical and chemical changes by conducting simple experiments. They discovered types of forces around them by using day to day objects.

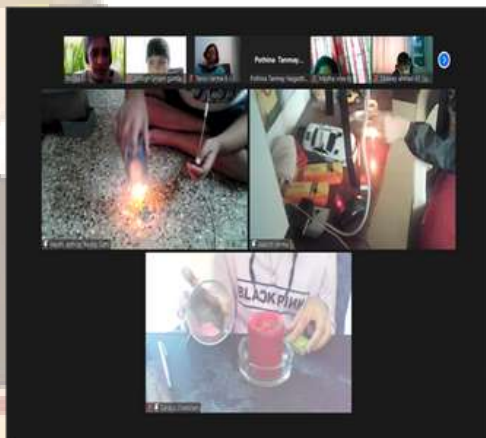


Hindi: Students created beautiful posters depicting types of nouns (sangya ke bhed).



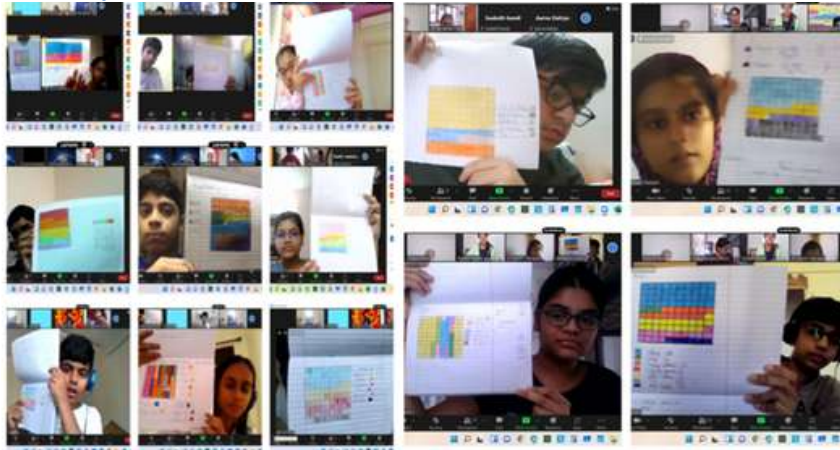
Grade 6

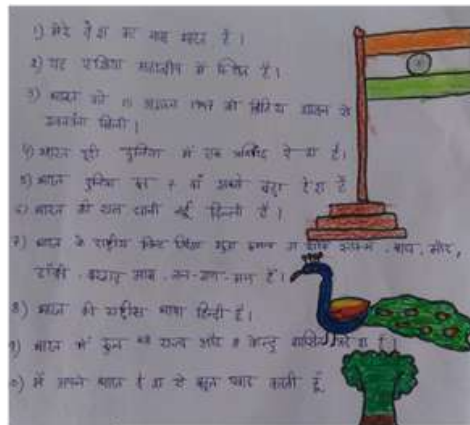
Grade 7

SUBJECT ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES

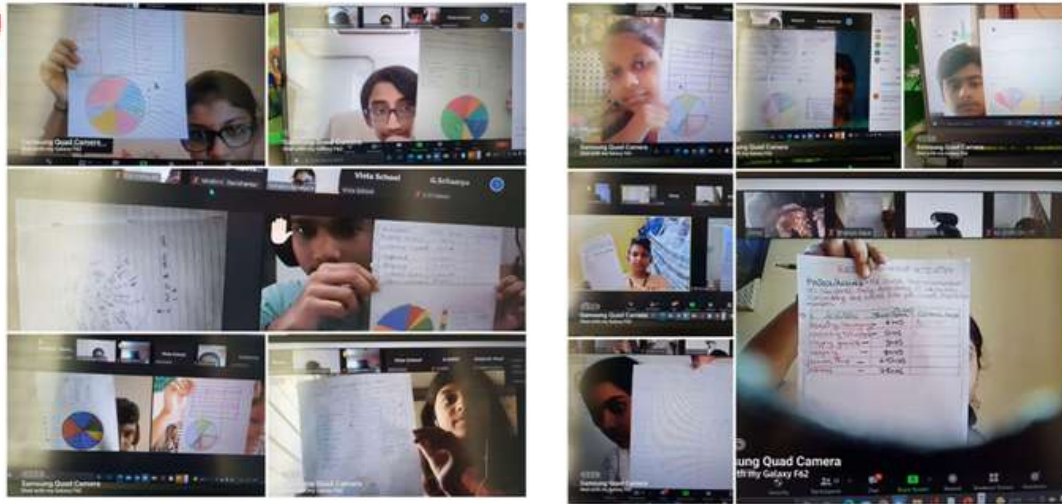
Grade 6: 3rd language Hindi- Students showcased their nation pride by writing about India creatively.

Grade 8: Math- Students performed Subject enrichment Activity in which they reflected on time spent on daily activities and represented it on a pie chart.

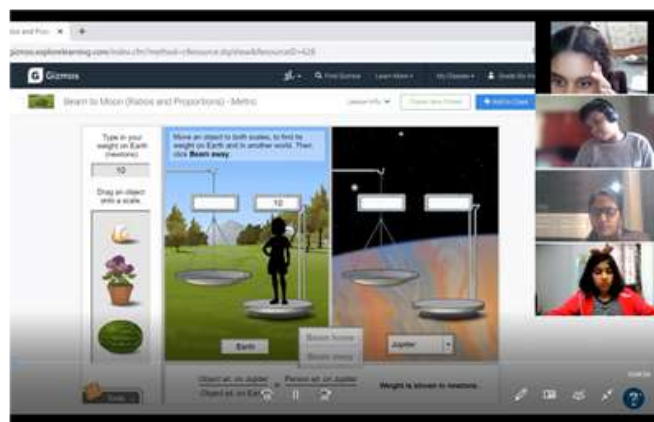


Gizmos

CCA Clubs saw students having a blast as they displayed creativity in their chosen clubs. Here are a few glimpses of club activities across grades V to VIII.

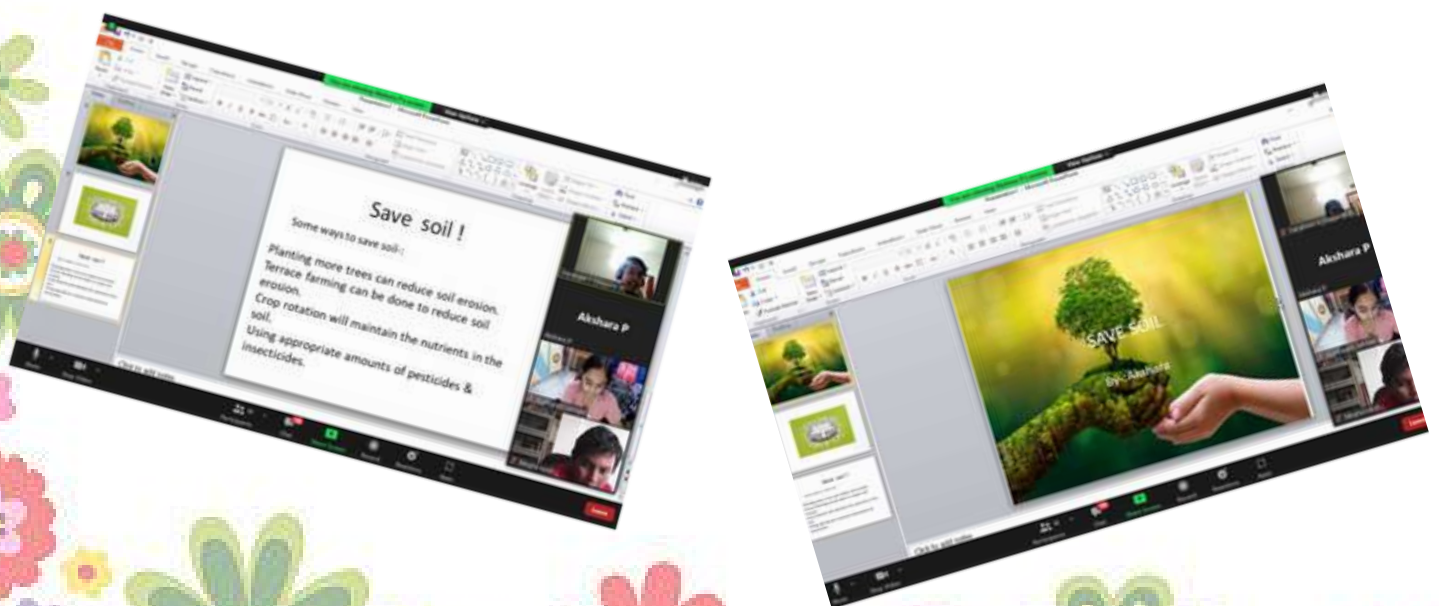

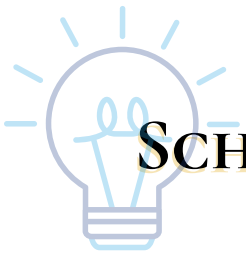
