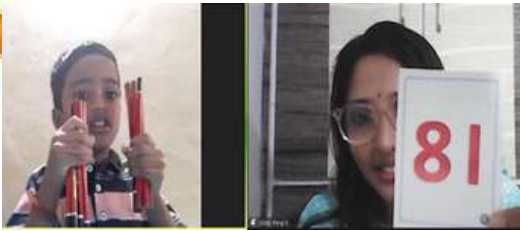

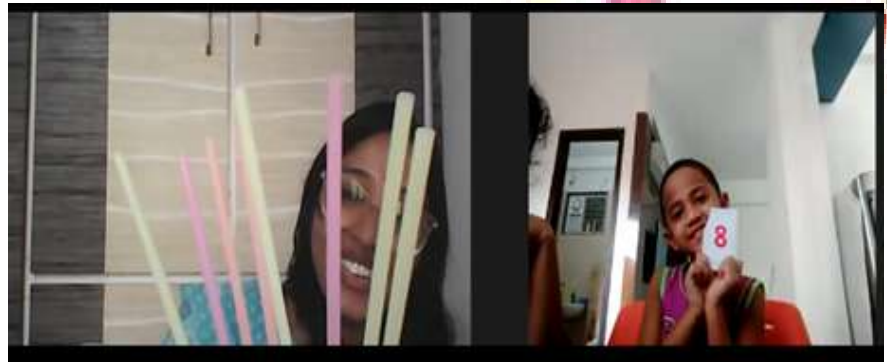

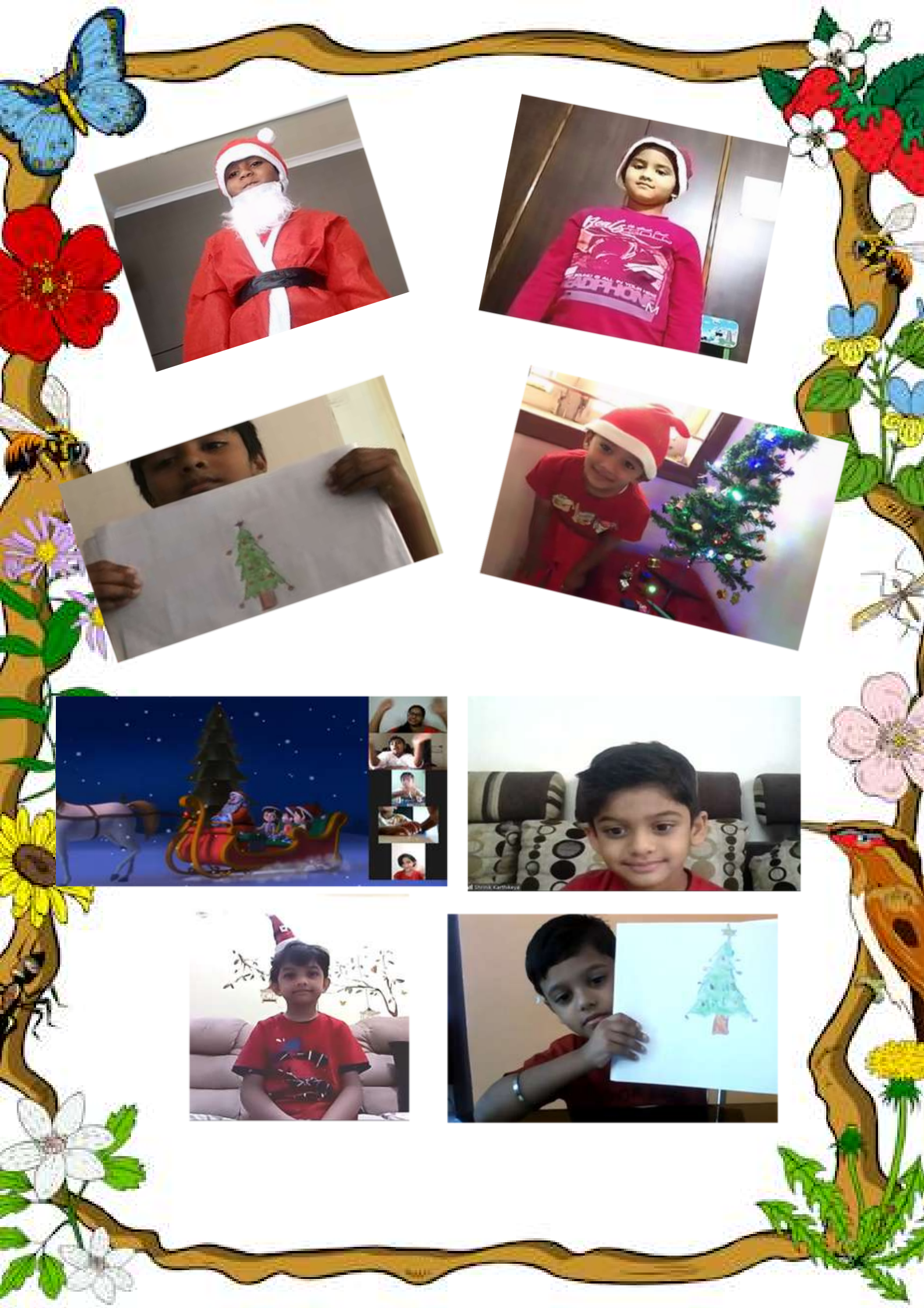


CHRISTMAS CELEBRATIONS – Jingle all the way!
