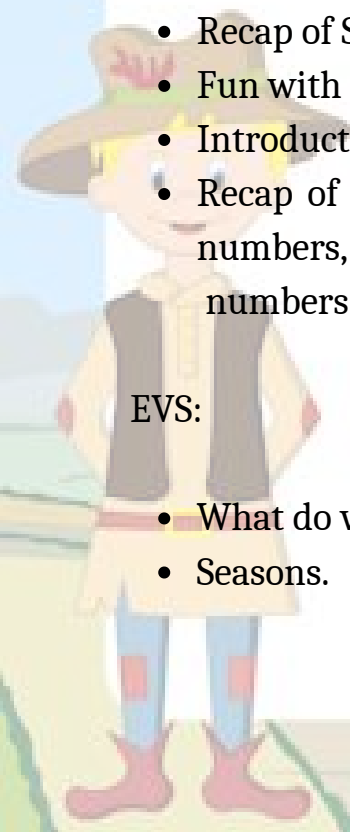

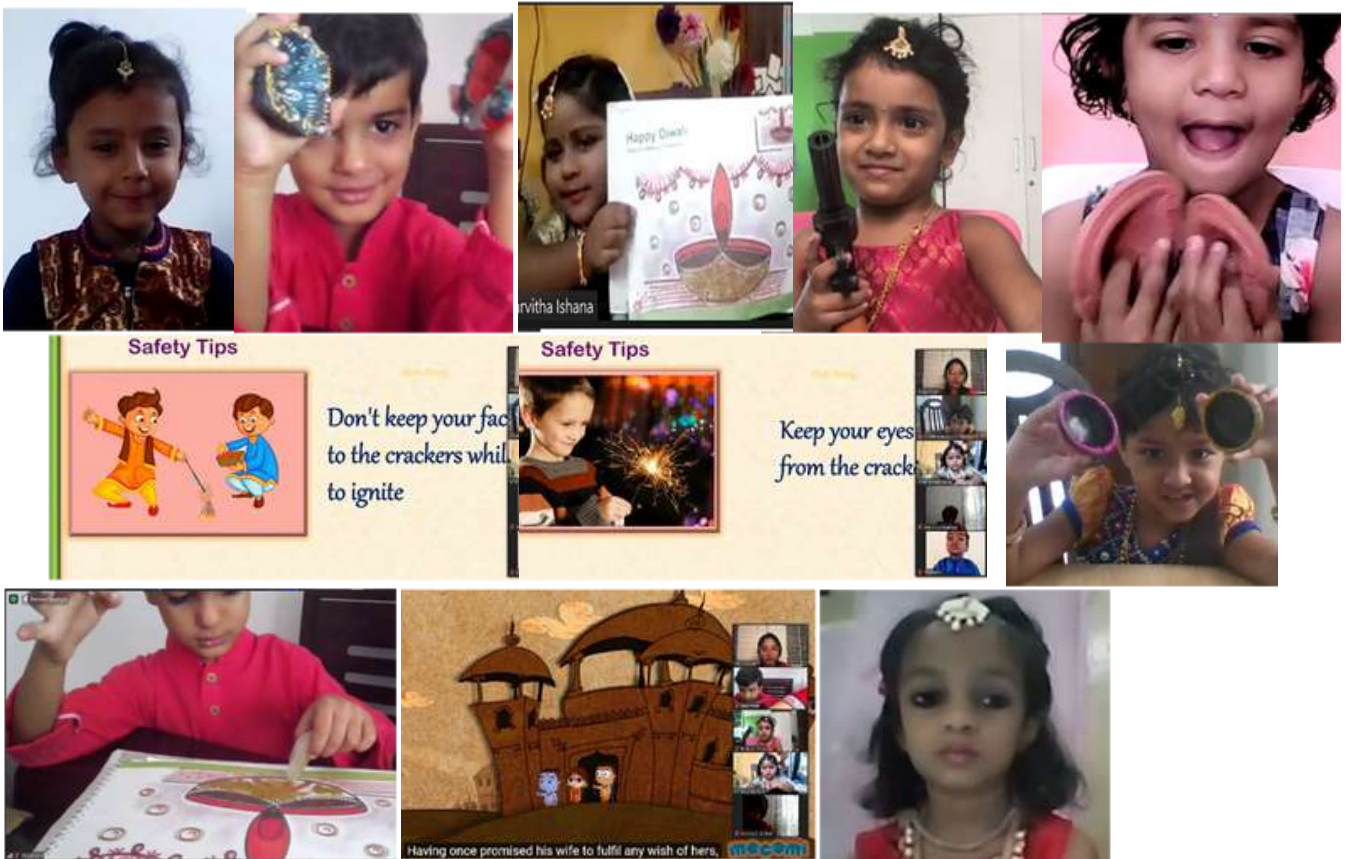

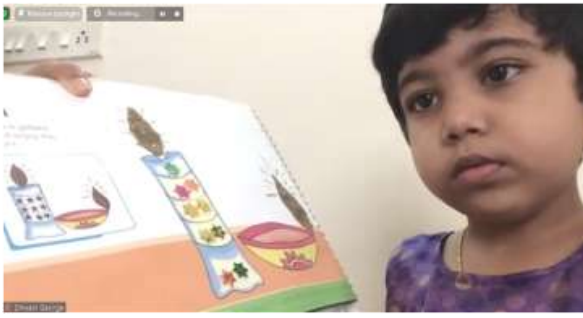


Diwali Celebrations

Fireless Cooking Activity

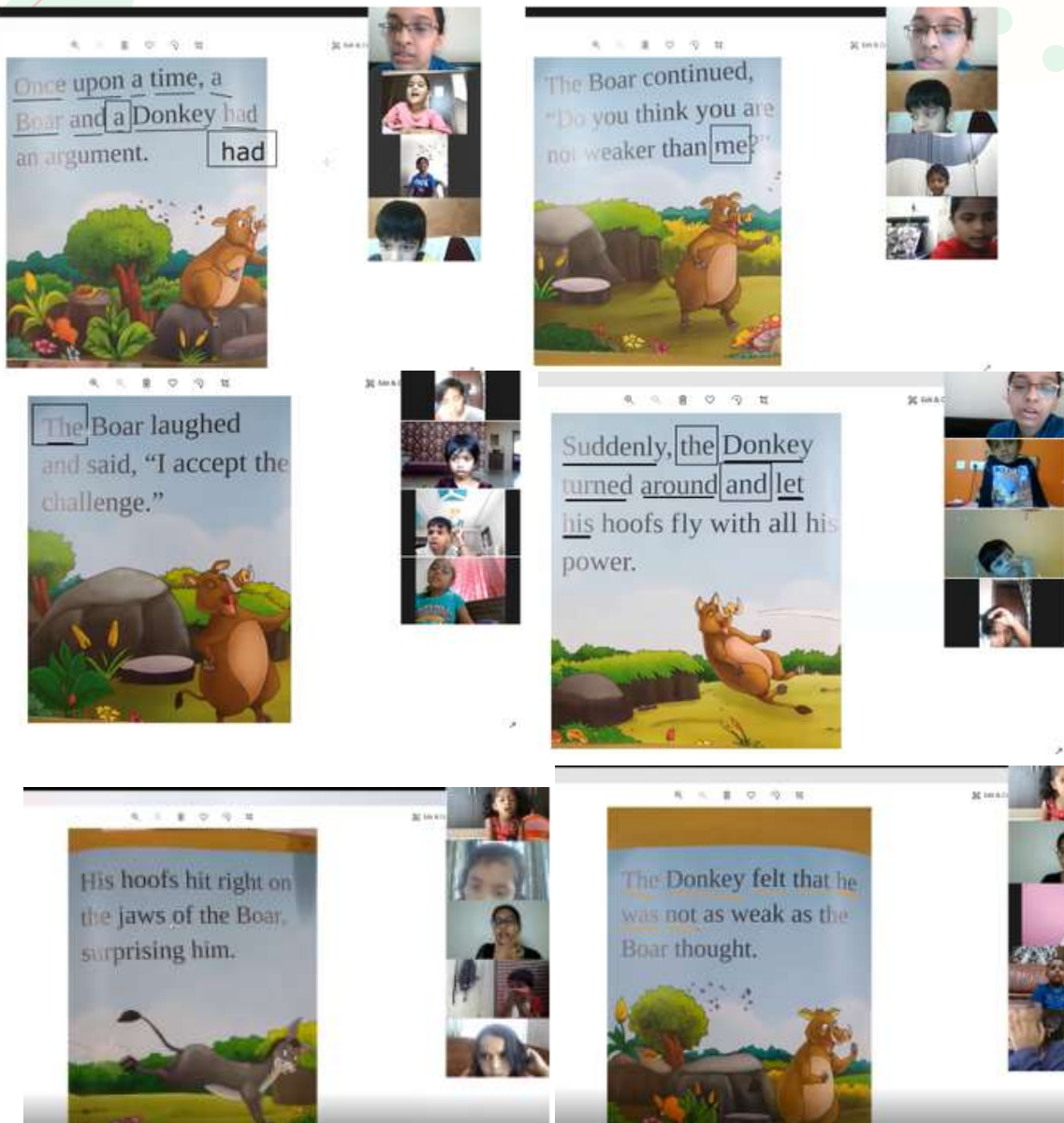

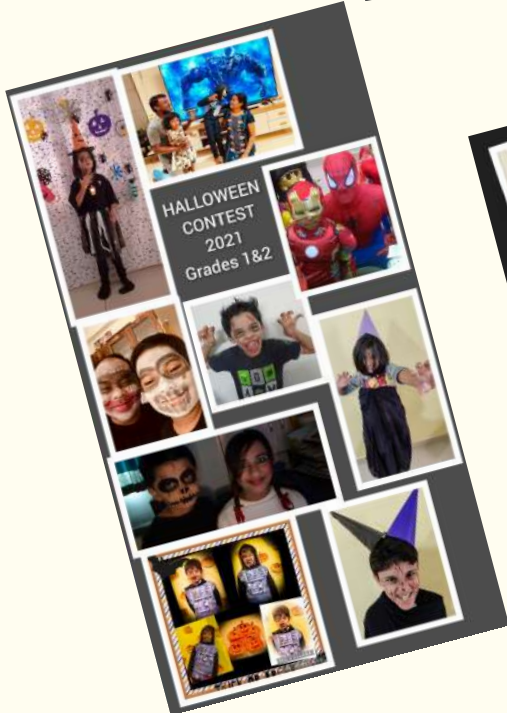


Decennial Celebrations
