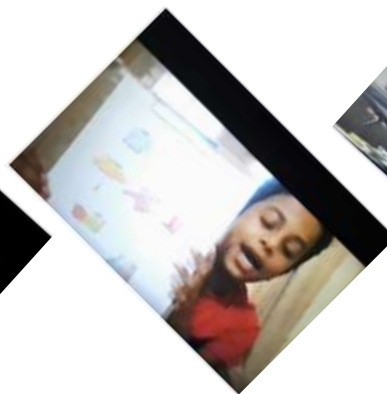
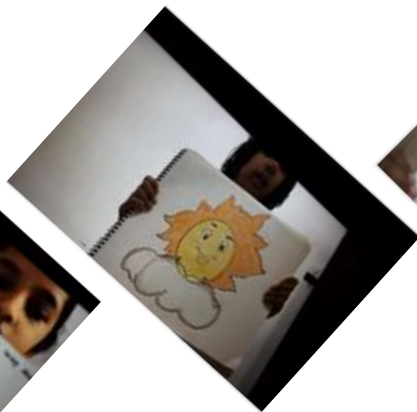


CLASSROOM ACTIVITIES

As part of math SEA activity in Grade 1 learners made groups of equals using different objects in their house.



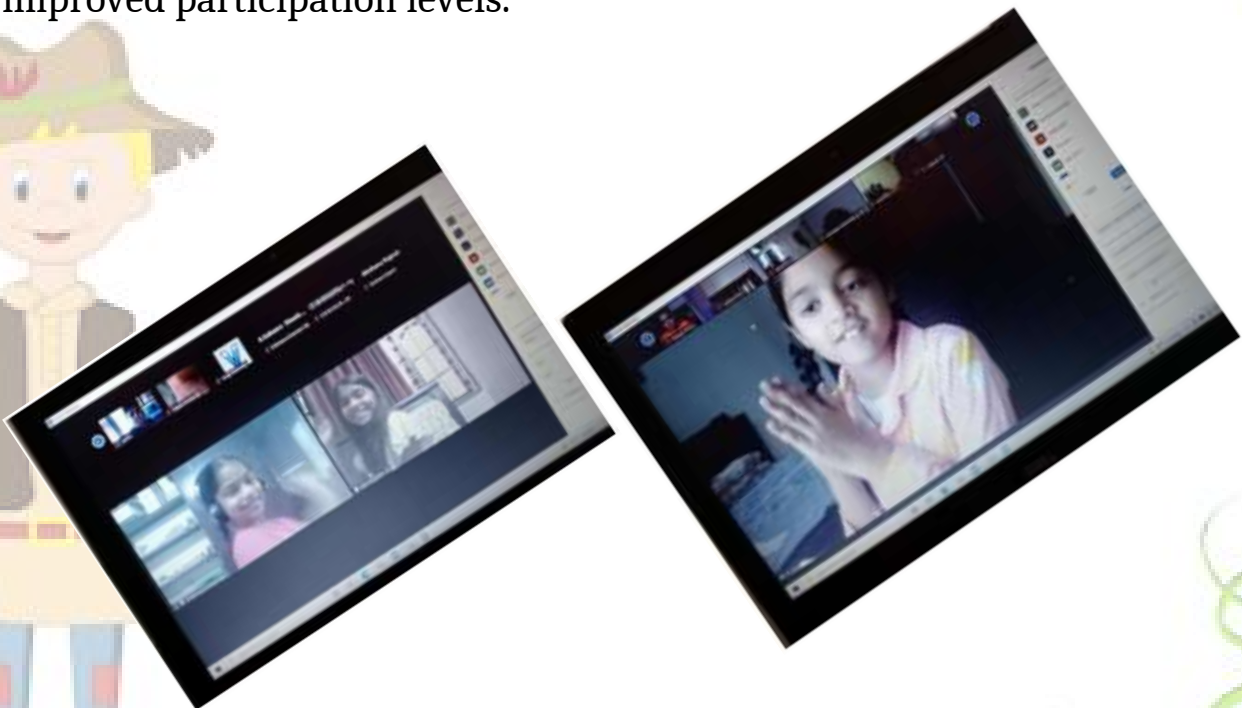
As part of EVS class activities students showed different seasons, weather conditions and the clothes we wear through the beautiful pictures that they drew.

Social Science Activity: FESTIVALS - “Festivals help us embrace our culture, in other words festivals fill our lives with colours and enthusiasm.”

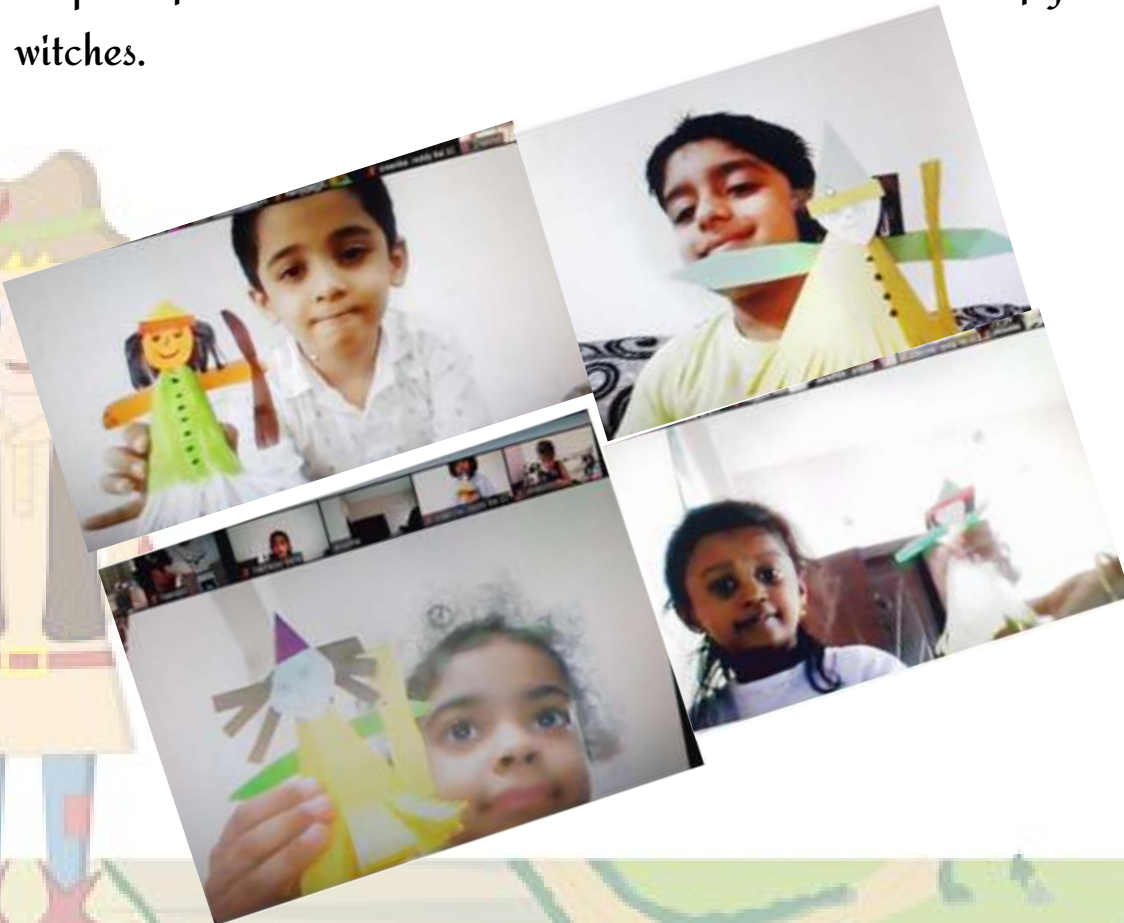
To make sure students understand the significance and story behind celebrating different festivals, an activity to cater to the same has been conducted in Grade - 4.

Grade 1:

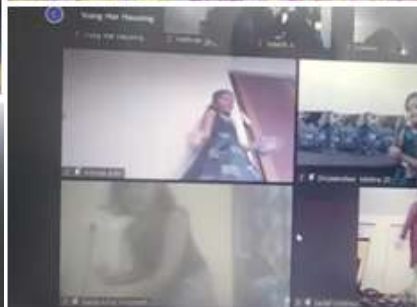
As part of Halloween celebrations children made cute little figures of witches.

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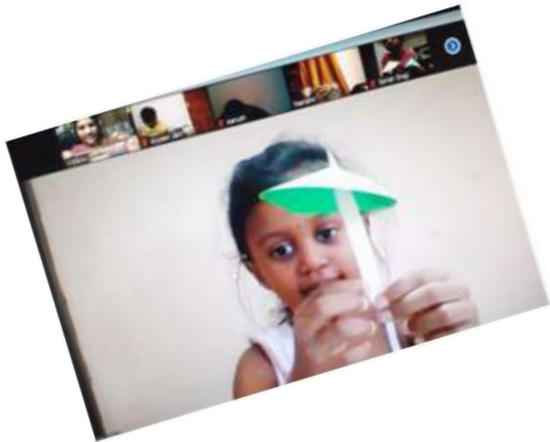


Co-Curricular Activities
