Greetings from Vista!

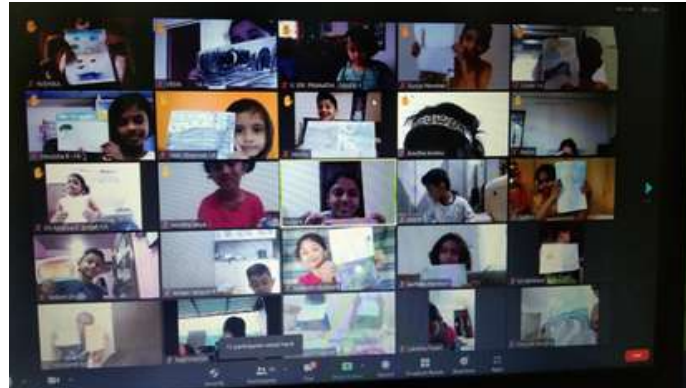

ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

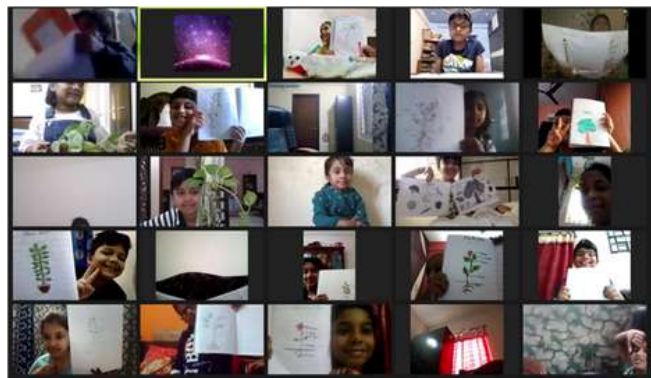
Grade 1

EVS- As part of the lesson 'Earth, Sky and Us', all the students showcased their artistic skills by drawing the day and night sky.



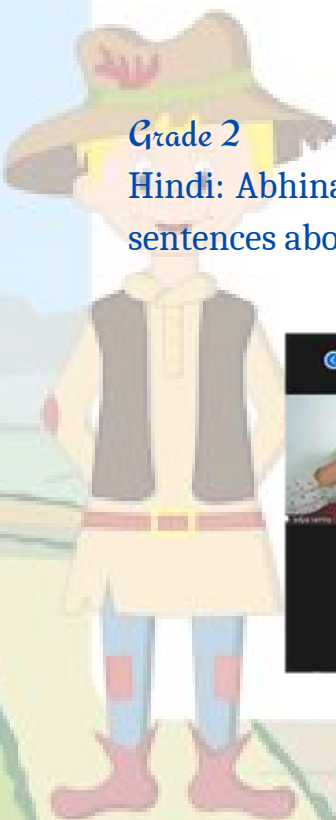
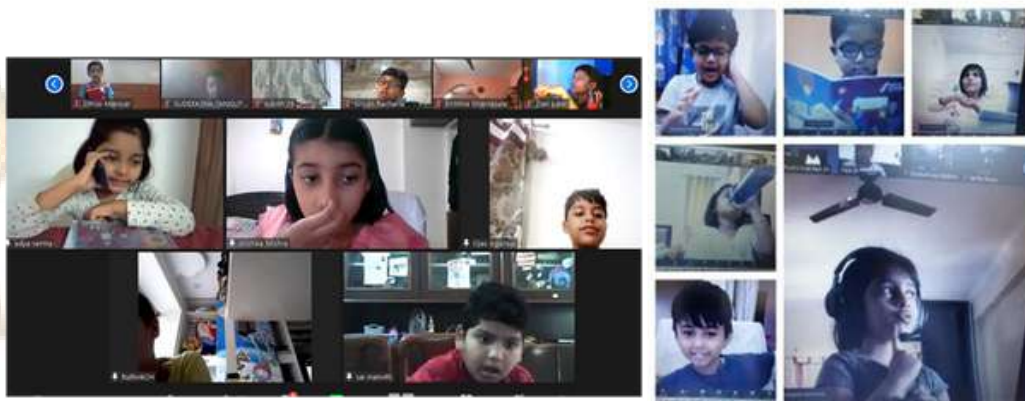
Grade 2

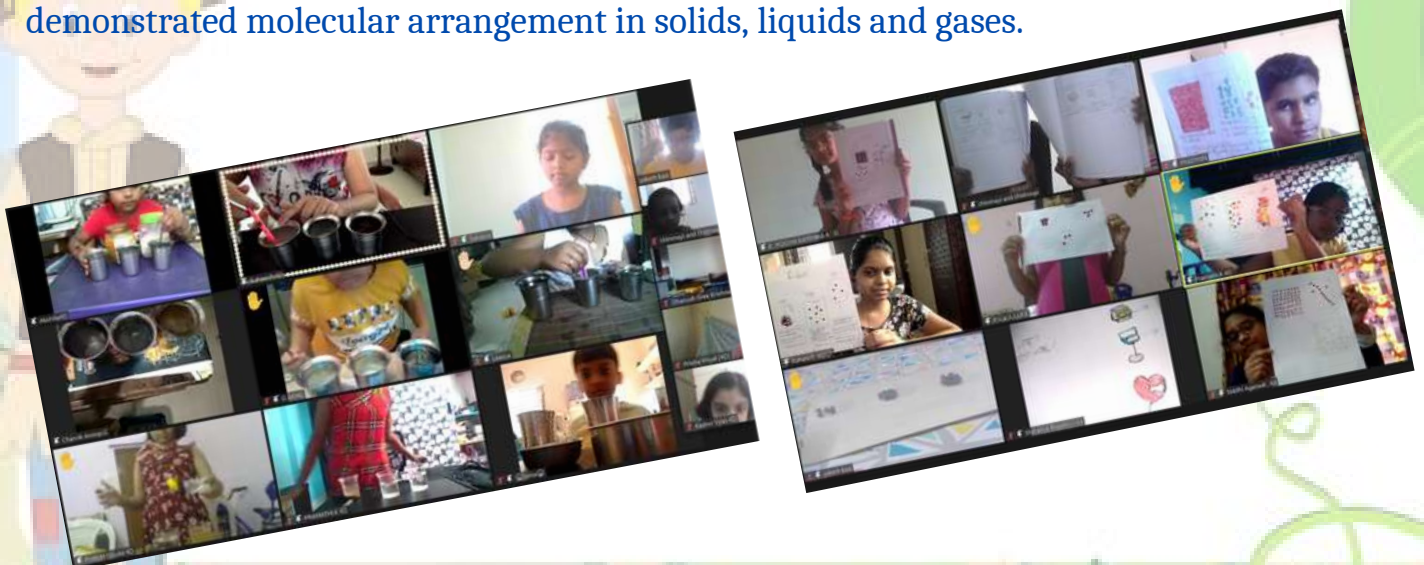
Grade 3

SUBJECT ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES

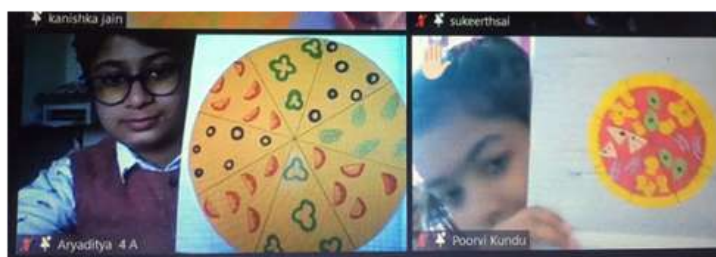
GRADE 4

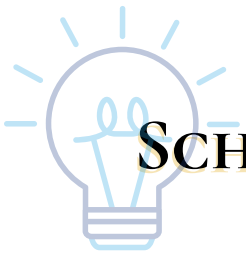
Picture Winners
