Students were asked to draw their favorite fruits and vegetables. They took out their sketchbooks and got to work in no time!

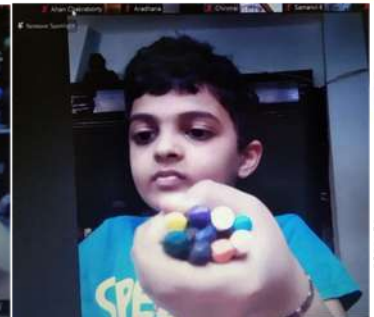


Students were asked to draw their favorite cartoon character as part of the chapter About Myself which they were learning.

Grade-2: EVS objective: Children observed growth of plants in different stages



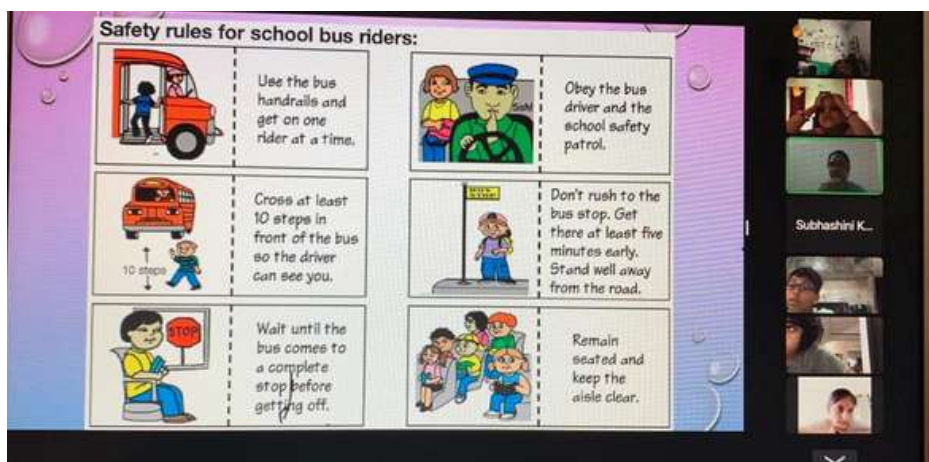
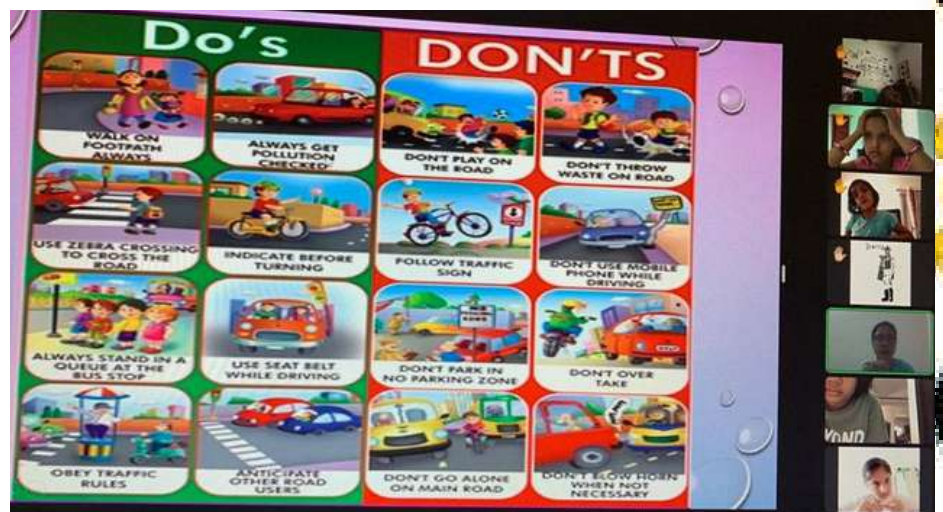
Activity: Model of lungs
